REQUEST TO SCHEDULE EVIDENTIARY HEARING

The Citizens of Florida ("Citizens"), by and through Jack joined by Amelia Island Community Public Counsel, Association, Residence Condominium, Residence Property Owners Association, Amelia Retreat Condominium Association, Amelia Surf and Racquet Property Owners Association and Sandpiper Association ("Nassau Associations"), by and through Arthur I. Jacobs, their attorney, the Concerned Citizens of Lehigh Acres ("Lehigh Acres") Sugarmill Woods Civic Association, Inc. ("Sugarmill Woods"), Spring Hill Civic Association, Inc. ("Spring Hill"), Marco Island Civic Association, Inc. ("Marco Island"), Harbour Woods Civic Association ("Harbour Woods"), and the Board of Supervisors of the East County Water Control District ("East County Water Control District"), by and through Michael B. Twomey, their attorney, request the Commission to schedule an evidentiary hearing on the motion to dismiss filed today.

- 1. The motion to dismiss filed today requests the Commission to dismiss the application for a rate increase of Southern States Utilities, Inc. ("Southern States") because of misconduct by Southern States interfering with the due process rights of the parties.
- 2. Under the case of <u>Jennings v. Dade County</u>, 589 So.2d 1337, 1342 (Fla. 3d D.C.A. 1991), the movants are entitled to an evidentiary hearing on the motion.
- 3. Although the Commission has already heard considerable evidence under oath from the public supporting portions of the motion to dismiss, it will be necessary to serve subpoenas to compel the attendance of other witnesses at an evidentiary hearing. The Citizens, Nassau Associations, Lehigh Acres, Sugarmill Woods, Spring Hill, Marco Island, Harbour Woods, and East County Water Control District request the Commission to issue a schedule sufficiently in advance of an evidentiary hearing so that subpoenas may be served.

WHEREFORE, the Citizens, Nassau Associations, Lehigh Acres, Sugarmill Woods, Spring Hill, Marco Island, Harbour Woods, and East County Water Control District request the Commission to schedule an evidentiary hearing on the motion to dismiss filed today.
