Re: Docket No. ~~951235-WB~~, Resolution of Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County Declaring Manatee County Subject to the Provisions of Chapter 367, Florida Statutes - Request for non-jurisdictional finding for provision of water service by CAMP FLYING EAGLE.

The attached application for a non-jurisdictional finding was recently filed with the Commission on behalf of Camp Flying Eagle. Mr. B. L. Pratt completed the application in response to the attached March 5, 1996, letter from staff. As stated on the front of the form, the application must be signed by an "owner." In this case, an owner would be a corporate officer of Southwest Florida Council, Inc. I am attaching a revised form for signature by an officer of the Council.

There is one other issue that needs to be resolved with regard to the application. Commission orders can only be issued to entities properly registered with the State. The Southwest Florida Council is properly registered as a Florida corporation. However, Camp Flying Eagle is not registered as a fictitious name for the Council. You need to contact the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations at (904) 488-9000 to find out whether or not the camp is required to be registered as a fictitious name. If so, please include a copy of your filing for a fictitious name along with the revised application.



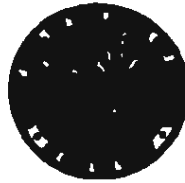
