CASE BACKGROUND

Staff has discovered that certificate number 3403 belonging to Yvanne Mesidor was cancelled in error. Yvanne Mesidor has requested that the certificate be reinstated.

Docket number 951409-TC was opened to cancel Certificate No. 3403 at the December 12, 1995 Agenda for non-payment of the Regulatory Assessment Fee. The payphone provider was then assessed a \$250 fine. Once the Order was sent to them regarding the delinquent Fee and Fine, the applicant paid the fine and fees in the amount of \$300, which was deposited by Staff on January 30, 1996. Case management did not reflect that the fine was paid; therefore, Certificate Number 3403 was cancelled on May 10, 1996. Staff received full payment within the protest period and believes that Yvanne Mesidor's certificate should be reinstated as requested.

**DISCUSSION OF ISSUES**

**ISSUE 1:** Should certificate number 3403 issued to Yvanne Mesidor be reinstated?

**RECOMMENDATION:** Yes.

**STAFF ANALYSIS:** Since Yvanne Mesidor paid the Regulatory Assessment Fee and Fine in a timely manner, staff recommends that the certificate be reinstated.

**ISSUE 2:** Should this docket be closed?

**RECOMMENDATION:** Yes.

**STAFF ANALYSIS:** Unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by this Order files a protest within 21 days, this docket should be closed after the conclusion of the 30 day period.
