Re: Transfer of Assets from Pennsylvania Alternative Communications, Inc. to LCI International Telecom Corp. -- Docket No. 960682-TI

Dear Ms. Bayo:

On May 31, 1996, LCI International Telecom Corp. ("LCI Telecom") and Pennsylvania Alternative Communications, Inc. ("PACE") filed a letter with the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") notifying the Commission of their intention to transfer selected assets from PACE to LCI Telecom. This letter was assigned Docket No. 960682-TI. By letter dated June 12, 1996, LCI Telecom and PACE requested that the Commission cancel PACE's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity upon consummation of the transfer of assets, which they anticipate will be on June 28, 1996. PACE received its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessi'7 on February 12, 1993 in Docket No. 920974, Order No. PSC-93-0121-FJF-TI, Certificate No. 3146.

The assets to be transferred from PACE to LCI Telecom include: (1) all of PACE's retail long distance telecommunications services customer accounts; (2) all of PACE's rights with respect to its sales agents and sales agencies and all records, payment and other information related thereto; and (3) all dialer equipment and other assets necessary to provide service to PACE's dialer customers. PACE's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity will not be transferred as LCI Telecom has its own operating authority.
