As you know, it is the opinion of the Commission staff that Telecuba is an uncertificated reseller of de bit card services in violation of Rule 25-24.470, Florida Administrative Code. The question of whether Telecuba is required to obtain a certificate will be resolved through the hearing process in Docket No. 960217-TI. It was my understanding that Telecuba had voluntarily ceased selling debit cards in Florida until this matter was resolved. However, it was recently reported to the Commission staff that Telecuba is continuing to sell debit cards in Florida.
