RE: Docket No. <u>961197-7C</u> Waiver of Rule 25-4.076(6), F.A.C.

Enclosed please find the original and fifteen copies of our request for waiver of Rule 25-4.076(6), F.A.C. which we ask that you file in the above captioned matter.

We request that the pay telephones located at the addresses below be exempted from the provisions of Rule 25-4.076(6), Florida Administrative Code, which requires that all pay telephone stations must allow incoming calls to be received "with the exception of those located at penal institutions, hospitals and schools and at locations specifically exempted by the Commission." The locations and numbers of the public telephones are as follows:

The Police Department has requested that we submit these requests for a waiver of the rule because of the use of the pay telephones at these locations for allegedly illegal activities. They believe the waiver will restrict the usefulness of the pay telephones for these individuals. These locations do not fit within the delineated exceptions to the rule and therefore these requests for waiver are appropriate.

The location providers for the locations identified above have either joined in or agreed to these requests for waiver which are attached.

The Commission has previously granted a waiver of this Rule in Order No. 23762, issued November 15, 1990, approving Southern Bell's petition for waiver of the rule for pay telephones located at three laundromats owned by Mr. Patrick Collins in Miami, Florida. The owner had requested blocking of incoming calls to restrict the usefulness of the public phone for drug dealers and prostitutes.

Please advise by Order if our requests for the waiver have been accepted.
