COMMISSIONER KIESLING: Before I go through 1 three pages of explanation of the process, do we have 2 3 anyone signed up? MR. SHREVE: (Shaking head.) COMMISSIONER CLARK: No? 5 6 MR. SHREVE: No. COMMISSIONER KIESLING: Why don't we go 7 ahead and give it five or ten minutes and see if 8 anyone comes late, and if they don't, then we'll 9 adjourn the hearing. 10 11 (Brief recess.) 12 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Let's try it again. 13 Call the hearing to order again. So, you know, we still want to hear from any customers that have comments or want to have some input on this. So anyone who wants to, can contact us by phone, by

e-mail-mail, which our e-mail address is in here, or they can send in written comments. So I appreciate you passing that on to your readers, and I'm sure that isn't enough news for you to care about putting on the TV tonight. (Thereupon, the hearing concluded at 6:45 p.m.)
