- 11. Sprint letters to MCImetro, dated September 17, 18, 19, providing Sprint's initial input on the MCImetro contract. Also provided some generic feedback on the document. Provided the Wholesale tariff filed in Illinois. Provided second draft of physical collocation tariff verbiage that would be filed in interstate access and be used as model for intrastate and local collocation.
- 12. September 23, 24, 25: Meeting to discuss/negotiate contract language. Several sections of the contract were covered, some were not. Action items were identified for both sides. At Sprint's suggestion, parties agreed to have subject matter experts discuss contract language directly via conference calls to facilitate those discussions.
- 13. During the September 24 meeting, provided revised version of Sprint Contract to MCImetro.
- 14. Sprint letter to MCImetro, dated October 4, 1996, providing follow-up on most of Sprint's action items from September 23, 24, 25 meeting. Acknowledged that SMEs were beginning direct discussions. Tentatively set October 16, 17, 18 for second round of discussions.
- 15. Sprint letter to MCImetro, dated October 14, 1996, providing Sprint's Avoided cost study methodology and corporate wide study results. Also provided the physical collocation tariff filing made with the FCC on October 11.
- 16. October 17 & 18: Meeting to further discuss/negotiate contract language. MCI did not provide any updates on its action items from the first meeting prior to this session. A red-lined version of the contract was provided by MCI on a diskette. This purportedly includes some revisions discussed during first meeting, and some changes that MCI made on its own.
