- Certificate number 2000 was issued to Coin Velephone of Central Florida May 24, 1988.
- The Division of Records and Reporting received returned mail from the Post office on this company. They asked that they be furnished with the correct mailing addre:s: or that staff initiate proceedings to have the provider's certificate cancelled. (Page 4)
- Communications staff attempted unsuccessifully to reach the provider by calling the telephone number listed in the Master Commission Directory. The number tor Coin Telephone of Central Florida is no longer in service.

## DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should Coin Telephone of central fioridit have it:s certificate cancelled by the Florida Public servic. Commissision tor violation of Rule $25-24.320(1)(a)$ and (t) , Floridu Admint:stidt ive Code, Reporting Requitements, if it tails to pay $-52,0$ tinc, and provide stafi with the information required by kule $25-24.520$ (1) (a) and (b), Florida Administrative Foff, peporting Requirement:s?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. statt recommends thit foin Telephone of Central Florida have its certiticate cancelled it it fails to pay a $\$ 250$ fine and provide staff with the information required by Rule 25-24.520(1) (a) and (b), Florida Adminisitrotive code, Reporting Requirements, within 30 days atter the order tocomes: $t$ inal. The fine is to be paid to the Florida Public sirtvice Commisasion and forwarded to the oftice of the comptrollet tot fepmsit in thr General Revenue Fund pursuant to $364.289(1)$, Iforidit ititutess.

Therefore, staff recommends that the certificate be cancelled unless the company pays is $\$ 2^{5} 0$ tinc and provides staff with the information requared by Rule $25-$ 24.520(1)(a) and (b), Florida Amintstrative Code, Reporting Requirements, within 30 days atter the order becomes final.

ISSUE 2: Should this iocket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. This docket should be .losici it no person whose substantial interests are affected files i fuotest within 21 days of the issuance of the order. If no timely protest is filed, this docket should be closed at the conclusion of the 30 day period after the Order becomes final. If the company pays the $\$ 250$ ifne and provides the information required, the docket should be closed.

## STAFF ANALYSIS:

- If the Commission adopts staf $\mathrm{f}^{\prime}$ 's recommendation in lissue 1, then Coin Telephone of Central Florida will have so days from the date the order becomes: f inal to pay a $\$ 2.0$ tine and provide statithe information called for in kule $25-24.520(1)($ (a) and (b), Florida Auministrative code, Reporting Requirements, or their cortiticate will be cancelled without further Commission action. Unless a person whose substantial interest:s wte ittected by this Order 1 iless a protest within 21 diyys tho docket should be closed after the conclusion of the :0 d.1y period.
- If this certificate is cancelled, thr serving local exchange company shall be notitiea by sitatito to discontinue siervice to all pay telophon, operated by that company. It the Commission denies stat on 1 issiue 1 the docket :inould be closed.
