- Peoples' requested conservation cost recovery factors 3. were calculated consistently and in compliance with Commission's order establishing annual ECCR factors, Order No. PSC 93-0709-FOF-EG, and with the Commission's prescribed methodology. The factors are designed to recover Peoples' projected conservation program expenses for the period April 1997 through March 1998, adjusted for (a) the estimated conservation true-up for the period October 1996 through September 1997, (b) the final conservation true-up for the period October 1995 through September 1996, and (c) interest provisions for both true-up amounts. The supporting documentation of these factors is presented in the prepared testimony and exhibits of Peoples' witness, Vernon I. Krutsinger, filed herein on November 19, 1996 and January 13, 1997, and which are incorporated by reference into this Petition. Exhibit VIK-2 includes the ECCR forms that Peoples and other utilities were directed to file by the Commission's Electric and Gas Department via memorandum dated June 17, 1982.
- 4. Peoples projects total conservation program expenses, net of all program revenues, of \$2,617,550 for the period October 1, 1997 through March 31, 1998. The net true-up is an underrecovery of \$739,612. After increasing the projected ECCR expenses by the amount of this underrecovery, \$3,357,162 remains to be recovered during the billing period April 1, 1997 through March 31, 1998.

When these expenses are allocated to the affected rate classes pursuant to the methodology approved by the Commission, expanded for tax effects, the recovery factors for the billing period April 1, 1997 through March 31, 1998 required to recover these expenses are as follows:

Residential Rate Class:		cents	per	therm
Commercial Street Lighting Rate Class:		cents	per	therm

wherefore, based on the foregoing, Peoples Gas System respectfully requests that the Commission approve the conservation cost recovery factors set forth above to be applied to bills rendered for meter readings taken between April 1, 1997 and March 31, 1998, inclusive.
