- My name is Lisa M. Nass. I am currently employed by Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) as Manager, Human Resources and Equal Opportunity. I have personal Knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.
- 2. The matters identified as exempt from disclosure pursuant to 366.093(f) consist of the employee numbers of certain FPL employees consisting of the last four digits of the social security numbers of such employees. Such information is employee personnel information unrelated to compensation, duties, qualifications, or responsibilities.
