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I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

We have applied the procedures described in Section II of this report to audit selected items of Exhibit 1 of Florida Power Corporation in support of Docket 970002-EG for the year ended December 31, 1996.

Recomputed residential base revenues. Traced residential active meters to Company's records. Traced residential billed customers to Company's records. Traced residential kilowatt hours billed to Company's records. Verified interest rates used for 'he interest provision.

Recomputed the interest provision.

Verified adjustments to the beginning balance.
