MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT THE RECORD

Gulf Utility Company (Gulf) files this its motion to supplement the record in this proceeding, and states:

- 1. At the hearing in this docket reference was made to Lee County reducing its reclaimed water rate to \$.04 per 1,000/gal.
- 2. In fact, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County took such action on April 2, 1997. The Board decided to reduce the reclaimed water rate to \$.04 per 1,000/gal. for the period from March 1, 1997 through May, 1998. The purpose of such action is to encourage the use of reclaimed water. Attached hereto is a copy of a letter from the Minutes Supervisor for the Board of County Commissioners, along with a copy of the Board's Minutes, which shows the passage by the Board of the reduction of the reclaimed water rate to \$.04 per 1,000/gal.

WHEREFORE, Gulf Utility Company moves that the Commission approve this Motion to Supplement the Record and receive Board of County Commissioners' Minutes into the record in this proceeding.

6. INDEPENDENT DIVISIONS

No requests received.

- 7. PUBLIC SERVICE DIVISIONS
 - (a) Request Board approve street name change of Orange River Boulevard to Lexington Avenue between Palm Beach Boulevard, west of I-75, and Lexington Avenue. This street name change is required to assist County forces and emergency response forces to identify the correct location of traffic crashes and other emergencies. This eliminates one of two intersections of Orange River Boulevard with Palm Beach Boulevard.

Commissioner Manning moved approval, seconded by Commissioner Albion, called and carried with Commissioner St. Cerny absent.

8. SOLID WASTE

No requests received.

- 9. TRANSPORTATION
 - (a) Request Board approve Utility License Agreement and Underground Distribution Facilities Installation Agreement with Florida Power and Light Company for construction of Treeline Avenue from Alico Road to Corkscrew Road for a not-to-exceed cost of \$481,344.00. Florida Gulf Coast University and property owners along Treeline Avenue have requested the power line be installed underground rather than overhead. This action will allow the Florida Power and Light Company's facilities to be installed underground.

Commissioner Manning moved approval, seconded by Commissioner Albion, called and carried with Commissioner St. Cerny absent.

(b) Request Board accept Easement Grant for a Bikepath/Walkway connecting County right-of-way to Lehigh Middle School and accept the Bikepath/Walkway for maintenance. This action provides the County with the right and authority to maintain an existing pedestrian walkway and conclusively establishes public right to use the existing Bikepath/Walkway traversing private residential property and leading to Lehigh Middle School. Costs, plus Recording Fees are \$989.21; Robert L. and Deirdre F. Waigand, owners.

PULLED FOR DISCUSSION
Commissioner Albion moved approval of this item, seconded by Commissioner
Manning. Commissioner Albion thanked the Waigands for giving this Easement for
a walkway to Lehigh Middle School. The motion was called and carried with
Commissioner St. Cerny absent.

10. UTILITIES

(a) Request Board approve the Low Demand Period Reclaimed Rate of \$0.04 per thousand gallons for reclaimed water used during the period from March 1, 1997, through May 31, 1998, to encourage use of the Fort Myers Beach Wastewater Treatment Plant (FMBWTP) reclaimed water by the reuse customers. This action is necessary to avoid possible discharge from the Fort Myers Beach Plant percolation pond system, and to further encourage cooperation and use of the reclaimed water, until a viable method of emergency disposal is available to prevent such discharges. This action lowers the reclaimed water rate which encourages the use of reclaimed water by the reuse customers.

PULLED FOR DISCUSSION
Since his family has property in this area, Commissioner Albion announced that he will be abstaining from voting on this item. Commissioner Manning moved approval of this item, seconded by Commissioner Judah, called and carried with Commissioner Albion abstaining and Commissioner St. Cerny absent.

(b) Request Board approve Supplemental Task Authorization #1 to CN #97-02 with Hole Montes and Associates Inc., for the design of the Balla.d Road Collection System Improvements Project, CIP #7221. Engineering
