COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida

Administrative Code, files its Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. On April 15, 1997, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) released Order No. 97-805 in CC Docket No. 96-128, which granted a limited waiver of the FCC's requirement that effective intrastate tariffs for payphone services be in compliance with federal guidelines, specifically that the tariffs comply with the "new services" test, as set forth in the payphone reclassification proceedings. This limited waiver was granted to all LECs until May 19, 1997. On April 30, 1997, BellSouth received from the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") Staff, a memorandum directing BellSouth to file certain information if BellSouth does not intend to amend its tariff.
- 2. BellSouth is filing such information on this date. The information contained in these documents is proprietary to BellSouth and includes, among other things, cost information. This information is clearly confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Section 364.183 and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.
