At its June 10, 1997, regular meeting, the Board of County Commissioners (the Board), of Clay County, Florida, directed that the Florida Public Service Commission be advised of the following matters:

- Policy 4.1 of the Community Facilities Element of the Clay County 2001 Comprehensive Plan provides in part: "Existing package treatment plants shall be connected to a central sewer system when those systems are within one-quarter mile."
- The Board has been advised by the Point Property Owners Association that the Clay County Utility Authority has the capacity to serve the existing users of the facilities for which certification is sought in the above-referenced proceeding.
- The Board has been advised by the Point Property Owners Association that the Clay County Utility Authority has an existing sewer force main within five hundred feet of the front entrance of The Point Condominiums.
