## NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Gulf Power Company, by and through its undersigned attorney and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby gives notice that it intends to request confidential classification for a portion of Gulf Power Company's Earnings Surveillance Report titled Supplemental Surveillance Report Information, Commercial/Industrial Service Rider, for June 1997, hereafter Supplemental 2, submitted to the Florida Public Service Commission Staff pursuant to Order No. PSC-96-1219-FOF-EI. A copy of Supplemental 2 is attached hereto as exhibit "A".

Supplemental 2 contains proprietary confidential business information regarding contractual matters which would cause irreparable harm to Gulf Power Company and the entity with whom it has contracted if such information is disclosed to the general public. Supplemental 2 also contains information relating to competitive interests which would cause irreparable harm to Gulf Power Company and the entity with whom it has contracted if such information is disclosed to the general public. The information for which confidential classification is sought is intended to be and treated by Gulf Power Company as private. A formal request for confidential classification will be filed within the time period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative
