## REQUEST FOR ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE

Gulf Utility Company (Gulf) files this its Request for Administrative Notice, and states:

1. Gulf requests that the Commission take administrative notice of the letter dated September 16, 1997 addressed to Mr. James Moore, President of Gulf Utility Company from the engineering firm of Montgomery Watson (attached as Appendix A). The Commission may administratively notice this letter pursuant to Section 90.202(12) and Section 90.203 of the Florida Evidence Code.

2. The facts stated in Appendix A should be administratively noticed because they are capable of accurate and ready determination by the Commission and its Staff. The Office of Public Counsel is being given this timely written notice of this request for administrative notice.

3. Montgomery Watson is an engineering firm. Montgomery Watson is the design and supervising engineer for the construction of the one million gallon reject holding tank (tank). In this proceeding, Gulf seeks the inclusion of this investment in its

approved rate base. The proper rate making treatment of this investment is shown on Appendix "B" attached hereto. This is the same Appendix B attached to Gulf's Motion for Reconsideration filed in this docket on July 30, 1997.

4. In its Motion for Reconsideration filed in this docket Gulf brought to the Commission's attention that Mr. James W. Moore, Gulf's president, had testified that construction of the tank would be completed by September, 1997. The attached Montgomery Watson letter (Appendix A) confirms that the tank will be "started up the week of Sept. 22, 1997 and will be in full operation by Sept. 30, 1997." The reference in the Montgomery Watson letter to Contracts A and B is to the contracts for the construction of the tank. The contracts are attached to Gulf's Motion for Reconsideration filed herein on July 30, 1997 as Appendix C.

5. This docket is currently scheduled for consideration by the Commission at its October 7, 1997 agenda conference. Prior to October 7, 1997 the Commission Staff and the Office of Public Counsel may make appropriate verification concerning the tank. The law is well established that the Commission should not ignore an existing fact which establishes a cost that will effect future rates. See <u>Gulf Power Company v. Bevis</u>, 289 So.2d 401 (1974) and <u>Marco Island Utilities, a Division of Deltona Utilities, Inc. v.</u> <u>Public Service Commission</u>, 566 So.2d 1325 (1st DCA 1990).

WHEREFORE, Gulf Utility Company requests that the Commission:

Take administrative notice of the letter from Montgomery
Watson dated September 16, 1997 and the facts stated therein;

2. Include in Gulf Utility Company's rate base the investment in the one million gallon reject holding tank and approve rates for the recovery of and return on the investment; and

3. Such other relief as may be appropriate.
