### SPRINT AND SMNI'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF MELISSA CLOSZ'S LATE-FILED EXHIBITS 91 AND 92

Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership ("Sprint") AND Sprint Metropolitan Networks, Inc. ("SMNI"), by and through their undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Commission Rules 25-22.006(4) and (5), Florida Administrative Code, file their request for confidential classification of portions of Late-Filed Hearing Exhibits 91 and 92 filed by Sprint/SMNI witness Melissa Closz in this docket, and in support thereof state:

1. During the hearing, Commission Staff requested Ms. Closz to provide Late-Filed Exhibits 91 and 92, which exhibits identify the types of Unbundled Network Elements (UNEs) order by SMNI and the number of business customers and subscriber lines in service by SMNI, and the number and types of interconnection trunks ordered by SMNI. Sprint and SMNI maintain that information contained in Late-Filed Exhibits 92 and 92 is confidential and proprietary.

2. Late-Filed Exhibit 91 identifies the types of UNEs ordered by SMNI. This information directly relates to SMNI's competitive interests. Disclosure of this information would impair SMNI's competitive business interests by allowing competitors to ascertain the precise configuration of SMNI's network of facilities

3. Late-Filed Exhibit 91 also identifies the number of business customers and subscriber lines in service by SMNI. This information relates to SMNI's competitive interests. Disclosure of this information would impair SMNI's competitive business interests by allowing competitors to determine the number of customers and business lines in service by SMNI and, thus, its relative market penetration and corresponding revenues. This information is intended to be and is treated by SMNI as proprietary and confidential.

4. Late-Filed Exhibit 92 identifies the number and type of interconnection trunks ordered by SMNI. This information also relates to SMNI's competitive interests. Disclosure of this information would impair SMNI's competitive business interests by allowing competitors to determine the amount of traffic being transmitted over SMNI's network. This information too is intended to be and is treated by SMNI as proprietary and confidential.

5. Sprint and SMNI request that the information described in paragraphs 2 through 4 above be classified as "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes. See Order No. PSC-97-1039-CFO-TL, issued September 2, 1997.

6. Sprint and SMNI file as Attachment "A" attached hereto a description of the confidential information contained in Late-Filed Exhibits 91 and 92.

7. Sprint and SMNI file as Attachment "B" attached hereto two copies of Late-Filed Exhibits 91 and 92 with the confidential information redacted.

8. Sprint and SMNI file as Attachment "C" attached hereto one copy of Exhibits 91 and 92 with the specific information asserted to be confidential highlighted.

9. Sprint and SMNI request that the information for which it seeks confidential classification remain confidential for a period of at least 18 months as provided in Section 364.183(4), Florida Statutes.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Sprint and SMNI respectfully request that its Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
