If the Commission's Order is not protested and the required information and fine are not received, certificate number 5156 should be canceled.

Issue 2: Should the Commission order all certificated interexchange companies (IXCs) to discontinue providing interexchange telecommunications service to Tel-Central pursuant to Rule 25-24.4701(3), Florida Administrative Code, if certificate number 5156 is canceled? Recommendation: Yes. Pursuant to Rule 25-24.4701(3), Florida Administrative Code, the Commission should order all certificated interexchange companies to discontinue providing interexchange telecommunications service to Tel-Central if Tel-Central's certificate is canceled at the conclusion of the protest period for failure to provide the required information, and failure to pay the fines as required in Issue 1. The Order should state that any IXC providing service to Tel-Central must contact the Commission at the conclusion of the protest period as set forth in the Order to determine whether the certificate has been canceled.

Issue 3: Should this docket be closed? Recommendation: If no person whose substantial interests are affected files a protest within 21 days of the issuance date of the Order, the Order will become final. Upon payment of the fines and receipt of the required information, or cancellation of the certificate, this docket should be closed.
