

<u>Issue 2</u>: Should APU be ordered to show cause within 20 days why it should not remit a statutory penalty in the amount of \$2,748.12 and \$879.40 in interest for violation of Section 350.113, Florida Statutes, Section 367.145, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.120, Florida Administrative Code, in that it failed to pay regulatory assessment fees for 1996? <u>Recommendation</u>: Yes. Staff recommends that APU be ordered to show cause within 20 days why it should not remit a statutory penalty in the amount of \$2,748.12 and \$879.40 in interest totaling \$3,627.52 for violation of Section 350.113, Florida Statutes, Section 367.145, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.120, Florida Administrative Code, in that it failed to pay regulatory assessment fees for 1996. Further, APU should be ordered to immediately remit \$10,992.47 in outstanding regulatory assessment fees for 1996. The show cause order should incorporate the conditions stated in the staff analysis.
