FLORIDA POWER CORPORATION'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Florida Power Corporation ("FPC"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C., requests confidential classification of the highlighted portions of the enclosed information which has previously been provided to the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") Audit Department in response to a Commission Review of Electric Service and Reliability conducted in 1997.

BACKGROUND

- In March, 1997, the Commission's Audits Department, at the request of the Division of Electric and Gas, launched a review of electric service and reliability (hereinafter referred to as the "Review").
- 2. During the course of the Review, FPC responded to numerous requests for information from the Commission's Audit Department. FPC's responses included i) information which contains confidential business information as defined in Section 366.093, specifically information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which could impair the competitive business of FPC (hereinafter referred to as "Competitive Information"); and ii) customer names and complaint records which were investigated by FPC (hereinafter referred to as the "Customer Information") (collectively referred to as the "Information").

- 3. The Competitive Information provided to the Audit Department in the course of the Review was gathered by FPC as part of its continuous effort to assess customer service issues so that FPC might develop products and services designed to fully meet customer expectations and in anticipation of greater competition in the electric market.
- 4. Three copies of the Information for which FPC seeks confidential treatment have been provided one copy with the Information highlighted and two additional copies with the Information blocked out. The Competitive Information is enclosed as Attachment A. The Customer Information is enclosed as Attachment B.

JUSTIFICATION FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

- Customer Information provided to FPC by its customers was received in confidence and public disclosure might serve to discourage future cooperation by customers in subsequent surveys or inhibit customers from reporting service issues to FPC or the Commission.
- 7. Disclosure of the Competitive Information would severely jeopardize FPC's future competitive position by providing third parties with access to specific and detailed customer information gathered through much time, effort and expense on the part of FPC.
- 8. FPC has maintained the Competitive Information in strict confidence and has used it for its own internal purposes. FPC disclosed the Competitive Information only as a result of the Review process. The Audit Department found the Information to be outside of the scope of the Review and has not included the Information in the Audit Department's draft report produced to the electric utilities in December, 1997, and which is scheduled for publication in January, 1998.

Therefore, confidential treatment of the Information will not affect the outcome of the Review.

WHEREFORE, Florida Power Corporation requests that the highlighted portions of the attached documents be classified confidential.
