Alternative Recommendation: No.



Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

<u>Primary Recommendation</u>: Yes. If Issue 1 is approved, this tariff should become effective on January 20, 1998. If a protest is filed within 21 days of issuance of the order, this tariff should remain in effect with any increase held subject to refund pending resolution of the protest. If no timely protest is filed, this docket should be closed.

### **APPROVED**

<u>Alternative Recommendation</u>: Yes. If Alternative Issue 1 is approved, this tariff should not become effective. If no timely protest is filed within 21 days of issuance of the order, this docket should be closed.
