2	CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Item 10.							
3	MS. BIEGALSKI: Commissioners, Item 10 is							
4	Staff's recommendation to Show Cause Minimum Rate							
5	Pricing for apparent slamming violations. There are							
6	two modifications I need to make.							
7	One is to update the number of consumer							
8	complaints closed as infractions, and that would be							
9	50, with the fine amount being modified to 500,000.							
10	And also the recommendation statement of							
11	Issue 1 should be modified to include the cancellation							
12	of Minimum Rate Pricing's certificate so that Minimum							
13	Rate Pricing will be required to Show Cause why it							
14	should not be fined or have its certificate cancelled.							
15	And Staff believes this is necessary in order to be							
16	consistent with prior recommendations.							
17	Minimum Rate Pricing was granted its							
18	certificate on May 7th of '96. A month after							
19	receiving its certificate the Division of Consumer							
20	Affairs started receiving complaints. An overwhelming							
21	majority of the complaints are related to the							
22	telemarketing activities of Minimum Rate Pricing. The							
23	consumers were led to believe that they were signing							
24	up for a discount plan, not switching their long							
25	distance provider.							

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1	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Is there anyone from							
2	the Company here to speak?							
3	MR. BOWMAN: I don't think they intend to							
4	make a presentation.							
5	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Oh, okay.							
6	COMMISSIONER GARCIA: I move Staff.							
7	COMMISSIONER CLARK: There's a motion.							
8	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Second.							
9	CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: There's a motion and a							
10	second. Any discussion? Showing none, show it							
11	approved unanimously.							
12	COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Let me ask something							
13	of Staff on this, because it was a discussion we had							
14	the other day with the phone cards. If in this case							
15	we go forward, and we decide to remove this company's							
16	certificate, immediately by that, included in the							
17	recommendation of Staff is that IXCs can no longer							
18	sell service to this company in Florida, correct?							
19	MR. BOWMAN: That's correct.							
20	COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Thank you.							
21	Madam Chairman, also I would like to ask if							
22	any of Robby Cunningham's staff is there. I think							
23	it's very important that we issue a press release on							
24	this, because we had hearings across the state, and I
