APPLICATION FOR LIMITED PROCEEDING INCREASE IN WATER AND WASTEWATER RATES

Applicant, Aloha Utilities, Inc. (hereinafter "Aloha". "Applicant" or "Utility"), pursuant to Sections 367.0822 and 367.081(1)(a) and (3), Florida Statutes, files this Application for limited proceeding increase in rates for water and wastewater service provided to the Utility's Seven Springs system in Pasco County, Florida, based upon the costs associated with Pasco County's (hereinafter referred to as "the County") required relocation of existing water and wastewater lines within the rightof-way of Little Road, a road owned and maintained by the County. The County required line relocations will result in substantial capital expenditure by the Utility and increased costs of providing water and wastewater service. Applicant is a Class A water and wastewater utility as defined by Rule 25-30.115(1), Florida Administrative Code ("F.A.C."). Its 1997 annualized revenues for the Utility's Seven Springs Systems totalled \$1,431,827 for water service and \$2,322,130 for wastewater service based upon the rates effective for those systems effective August 30, 1996.

I.

(a) The name and address of the applicant is:

Aloha Utilities, Inc. 2514 Aloha Place Holiday, Florida 34691

(b) Applicant's interest:

Applicant is a water and wastewater utility as defined by Section 367.021(12), Florida Statutes, and is not exempt from regulation by the Commission pursuant to Section 367.022, Florida Statutes. Except as provided in Section 367.081(4), Florida Statutes, Applicant's rates and charges may not be changed without approval of the Commission. The required investment in relocation of the Utility's existing lines will result in substantial expenditure of capital for which the Utility must receive increases in rates.

II.

Aloha began operations in 1970. In early 1997, Aloha was informed of the County's intention to widen a substantial portion of Little Road within Aloha's service territory. Widening this County road required relocation of a substantial portion of Aloha's water and wastewater mains. The road widening work was necessitated in large part by the development of Trinity Communities, a designated "development of regional impact" pursuant to § 380.06, Florida Statutes. In undertaking the road widening project pursuant to a Development Order with the County, Adam Smith Enterprises, Inc. (the owner of Trinity Communities), bid all portions of the work, including the relocation Aloha's lines. As a result of circumstances fully outlined in Schedule No. 1 of Exhibit "A" hereto, Aloha will be required to contract separately for the work

related to its line relocation at an amount equal to the portion of the joint project bid related to relocation of Aloha's lines. Aloha and the low bid contractor will proceed with construction immediately upon approval of rates by the Public Service Commission which allow Aloha to recover such costs. The estimate of Aloha's portion of the cost the relocation project is \$318,131, out of an estimated total project cost of approximately \$7,000,000.

III.

In an unprecedented move, the Commission has held rate relief in abeyance for Aloha's line relocation costs pursuant to the Florida Department of Transportation's State Road 54 Road Relocation Project in Docket No. 970536-WS. This has placed a serious financial burden on the Utility. Therefore, Aloha must wait for final Commission action authorizing an increase in rates to cover the required the Little Road project costs before it will be in position to finance, contract for, and construct this line relocation project. Immediately upon the Commission recognizing and authorizing an increase related to this project in accordance with the filings in this docket, Aloha will enter into a construction contract under the terms of, and in the amount of, the bid previously received, and will begin construction of the required facilities.

IV.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** is a group of 10 schedules prepared by Aloha's outside CPA, Cronin, Jackson, Nixon & Wilson reflecting the costs which will be incurred by Aloha as required by

the County for relocation of these facilities, as well as other pertinent information utilized to calculate the rate changes necessary in order to recover these increased costs.

v.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"** are revised tariff sheets to be utilized by the Utility in order to implement this change in rates. The present rates which are adjusted herein are those rates currently authorized for the Aloha's Seven Springs system. The rates authorized for the Utility should be those that will allow Aloha the opportunity to recover total additional revenue of \$41,683 for its Seven Springs sewer system and \$15,328 for its water system, as calculated in Schedules 2 and 3 of Exhibit A.

VI.

Because of the substantial capital expenditures required as a result of the County's Little Road widening project, and the urgency of undertaking that project, Aloha must request immediate increases in water and wastewater rates to its customers in its Seven Springs service area in order for it to continue operations, recover its costs, and earn a fair return on its investment as a result of this required investment. Rather than pursue a full rate case to recover the cost of this change in circumstances (at a substantially higher rate case cost), Aloha requests that these changes be recognized in a limited proceeding under the Commission's authority provided in Section 367.0822, Florida Statutes.

VII.

At this time, there are no known disputed issues of material fact in this matter.

VIII.

Because Pasco County is adamant that Aloha must proceed immediately to begin construction of the facilities for this road project, time is of the essence in the Commission granting the Utility authority to recover these line relocation costs. The Applicant is in immediate need of rate relief to recover such costs. Attached hereto as Exhibit "C" is a copy of a letter from the County requiring the line relocation and stating the urgency of moving forward with the construction and relocation of these facilities. Immediately upon approval of temporary or interim authority to increase rates once the facilities are in place and recognizing the costs of such facilities, Aloha will enter into a final Agreement for construction of those facilities as a prerequisite to the implementation of that rate relief granted.

IX.

Other information which the Applicant deems relevant is as follows:

(a) The filing fee submitted herewith is a check in the amount of \$4,500 as the appropriate filing fee for this application in accordance with Commission Rule 25-30.020(2)(g)6, F.A.C. for both water and wastewater systems with existing capacity to serve more than 4,000 ERCs.

Aloha Utilities, Inc. Limited Proceeding to Recover Line Relocation Costs Little Road Phase IIIB

Executive Summary

In early 1997, Aloha Utilities, Inc. became aware of the Little Road widening project in Pasco County. A portion of the project, located between State Road 54 and Massachusetts Avenue and the Little Road Bridge, would require utility line relocation by the Company. The Utility's consulting engineer, Dale D. Ernsberger, P.E., of Civil Engineering Associates, Inc., was instructed to coordinate with the County on the project. At that time, the Company expected, and in March, 1997, first requested a Joint Project Agreement which would incorporate Aloha's line relocation work with other utility relocation work and with the road contractor's overall construction contract. A Joint Project Agreement is a contract typically utilized by the Florida Department of Transportation and individual counties to coordinate road construction projects with the many utilities located in the right-of-way.

As a result of projected increases in traffic on Little Road, due to the Trinity Communities Development of Regional Impact ("Trinity Communities"), the project developer was required to widen Little Road as a condition of the DRI approval process. Adam Smith Enterprises, Inc. ("Adam Smith") is the developer of Trinity Communities and has entered into a Development Order, Capital Contribution Front Ending Agreement, Escrow Agreement, and other documents with Pasco County which evidence the Developer's obligation to construct certain infrastructure improvements required pursuant to the DRI process. Based on this arrangement, Pasco County took the position that Adam Smith was responsible for the road widening project and, conversely, the County had no such responsibility. This was a very unusual position, given the fact that the County owns the right-of-way, permits lines within the right-of-way, and exercises the authority to require a utility, such as Aloha, to remove and/or relocate its lines.

In the second quarter of 1997, Aloha worked with Adam Smith and the County by meeting with engineers and planners and providing preliminary engineering information for Aloha's line relocation. Adam Smith proceeded to issue bid packages for the project, which included not only Aloha's line relocation work, but also that of Pasco County which had water and wastewater lines to relocate. Kimmins Contracting Corporation was the low bidder, and Adam Smith subsequently signed a contract for its portion of the work.

In contrast, without providing any information regarding the bid process, the low bidder, the actual construction process, or how Aloha's customers would be protected against service interruptions, payment in full for Aloha's portion of the line relocation work was demanded by Adam Smith. When this information was requested prior to payment, Aloha was characterized as uncooperative and unprepared to relocate facilities, according to Adam Smith's preferred construction schedule. In August, Aloha advised the County of the circumstances and again requested a Joint Project Agreement to address these issues and to make clear each party's rights and duties with regard to payment, scheduling, construction bonding, service interruption, indemnification, etc.

Following several weeks of ther discussions between the part, on October 2nd, the County provided a proposed three-party Joint Project Agreement. The proposed Agreement lacked detail, failed to include protections for Aloha and its customers, was one-sided in its approach and, in general, was wholly inadequate to protect the interest of Aloha Utilities. Aloha then proposed to use the same Joint Project Agreement which the County had entered into with Adam Smith to address its own utility line relocation requirements. Inexplicably, this Agreement was now unacceptable to the parties.

The County has since taken the position that Adam Smith is responsible for the road widening, that Aloha is responsible for the utility line relocation, and that the County itself has no obligation. At the same time, Adam Smith has taken the position that its Development Order requires only that it widen Little Road and that it, too, has no responsibility for utility line relocation. Meanwhile, both parties are placing extreme pressure on Aloha to immediately relocate its lines to meet the Development Order and construction contract deadlines. Therefore, Aloha's only choice is to contract directly with Kimmins Contracting Corporation to perform the utility line relocation in a manner as if a Joint Project Agreement had been entered into. On that basis, the Kimmins bid and other bid information is being utilized to demonstrate Aloha's financial obligation, along with demand letters from the County evidencing Aloha's legal obligation to relocate its lines. We have reviewed the documents received from Florida Design Consultants and Adam Smith Enterprises, Inc., and have the following comments:

- 1. The Contract between Adam Smith and Kimmins Construction has the same Bid Proposal pages previously provided by Florida Design Consultants (FDC) and they are for the same dollar amounts. The quantities and item descriptions are the same as furnished to Florida Design consultants by CEA for the Aloha Utility relocation work.
- 2. The Bid Proposal pages for Pasco County are the same as those previously furnished and for the same quantities and dollar amounts. There are no revised Pasco County prices, so we cannot make any new comparisons between Aloha and Pasco County bid prices.
- 3. The Technical Specifications included in the Contract appear to be exact copies of the documents provided to FDC for this project by CEA.
- 4. The construction drawings for the Aloha Utility Relocation work, included in the complete project drawing set are those furnished to FDS for this project by CEA.
- 5. Kimmins Construction Co., Inc., is the low bidder for the Aloha Utility Relocation work. The apparent low bidder for the work is David Nelson Construction when only the base bid is considered, \$270,817.50 for Nelson versus \$280,668.00 for Kimmins.

Two line items were added to the base bid for the total bid. These were 5% for Mobilization and 2% for Maintenance of Traffic.

Neither of the bidders actually entered 5% and 2% for these items. Nelson's total bid for these two items was \$18,000.00. Kimmin's total bid for these same two items was \$5,000.00. This leads to a total bid for Nelson of \$288,817.50 and \$285,668.00 for Kimmins. The Kimmins bid is the lowest bid for the Aloha Utilities relocation work on this project.

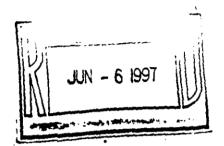

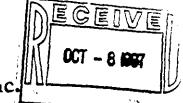

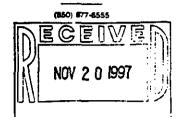
