## Marketing Conservation Research and Development Program Fourth Quarterly Report Report Period: Fourth Quarter 1997

## **Program Status:**

The FPL Marketing Conservation Research and Development Program (MCRD) was approved by the Commission in Order No. PSC-97-0100-FOF-EI dated January 27, 1997. This program is designed to allow FPL the flexibility to develop specific projects to test alternative incentive and / or marketing strategies for existing DSM programs.

Since this Program was approved, FPL has focused its efforts on redesigning the majority of its existing DSM programs. FPL has postponed the development of specific MCRD projects until its current DSM program modification petitions are finalized and implemented. FPL's redesigned DSM programs will be effective on March 1, 1998. FPL anticipates it will submit its first proposed project shortly thereafter.

## **Budget / Expenditures:**

The MCRD Program has an approved total cost capped at \$2,646,000 for the time period October 1996 through September 1999, with an annual cap of no more than \$1,134,000.

FPL's annual expenditures are \$5,703. FPL's program to date expenditures are \$5,703.
