PURPOSE

The purpose of this workshop is discuss the issue of public interest payphones and to form a work group to assist in the assessment of public interest payphones in Florida. Through this workshop, the Florida Public Service Commission staff will begin the review process as required by the Federal Communications Commission in its rule, 47 C.F.R. §64.1330(c). Section 64.1330(c) of Title 47 of the Code of Federal Regulations states in pertinent part: "Each state must review its rules and policies to determine whether it has provided for public interest payphones consistent with applicable Commission guidelines, evaluate whether it needs to take measures to ensure that such payphones will continue to exist in light of the Commission's implementation of Section 276 of the Communications Act, and administer and fund such programs so that such payphones are supported fairly and equitably ..."
