

## BEFORE THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

In re: Petition of Florida Cities Water Company for limited proceeding to recover environmental litigation costs for North and South Ft. Myers Divisions in Lee County and Barefoot Bay Division in Brevard County. DOCKET NO. 971663-WS

#### SYNOPSIS

1. Florida Cities Water Company (FCWC) has applied to the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) for approval of a rate increase applicable to customers in Lee and Brevard Counties. This application is being processed under PSC Docket No. 971663-WS.

2. The purpose of this petition is to seek approval for the recovery of a portion of FCWC's legal expenses incurred by FCWC in its successful defense of a legal action brought by the United States relating to alleged violations of the Clean Water Act ("CWA"). From 1992 through 1997, FCWC was the subject of an enforcement action initiated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") and prosecuted by the United States Department of Justice ("DOJ"). This enforcement action addressed a number of alleged violations of the Clean Water Act at three FCWC wastewater treatment facilities, Waterway Estates (Lee County), Barefoot Bay (Brevard County) and Carrollwood (Hillsborough County). At the height of the litigation the DOJ sought civil penalties in the amount of \$104,325,000. As a result of FCWC's defense, the final penalty assessed by the United States District

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Court was \$309,710. In addition to this reduced penalty, the Court found that FCWC had acted in good faith in its dealings with state and federal regulators, and that none of FCWC's actions caused environmental harm to the waters of the State of Florida.

FCWC does not seek the recovery of the amount of the civil penalties assessed by the court. FCWC incurred legal expenses in the amount of \$3,826,210. Of the \$3,826,210, FCWC is seeking to recover \$2,265,833 plus rate case expense from customers in Lee and Brevard counties. Recovery is sought through a monthly customer rate increase applicable to FCWC's water and wastewater customers in South Ft. Myers, North Ft. Myers (Lee County) and Barefoot Bay (Brevard County). FCWC proposes that it be allowed to collect this rate increase for a period of ten years or until such time as the expenses have been fully recovered, whichever occurs first.

The proposed rate increase to be collected from each water and each wastewater customer is based on meter size as follows:

Monthly Rate Increase
For Each Service
(Water and Wastewater)
By Meter Size

1.05
2.10

6.72

42.00

For example, a typical residential customer who receives both water

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and wastewater service would pay \$.42 for water and \$.42 for wastewater or a total of \$.84 monthly.

3. This Petition has been filed as a Petition for Limited Proceeding pursuant to Section 367.0822, Florida Statutes which provides in sub-section (1) as follows:

(1) Upon petition or by its own motion, the commission may conduct limited proceedings to consider, and act upon, any matter within its jurisdiction, including any matter the resolution of which requires a utility to adjust its rates. The commission shall determine the issues to be considered during such a proceeding and may grant or deny any request to expand the scope of the proceeding to include other related matters. However, unless the issue of rate of return is specifically addressed in the limited proceeding, the commission shall not adjust rates if the effect of the adjustment would be to change the last authorized rate of return.

4. The issue in the case is whether the Commission should approve FCWC's proposal to recover its legal expense incurred by FCWC in its successful defense of a legal action brought by the United States relating to alleged violations of the Clean Water Act.

5. The PSC staff will conduct an appropriate investigation for the purpose of discovering all relevant facts concerning FCWC's proposal. For the convenience of customers, hearings will be held in Ft. Myers and Barefoot Bay. A hearing will be held to receive all relevant testimony and exhibits from the parties. The PSC Staff will analyze the testimony and exhibits and make a recommendation to the PSC Commissioners. The PSC Commissioners at a scheduled agenda conference will consider the staff

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recommendation and all matters of record. The PSC at the agenda conference will make a decision and issue a final order setting forth the decision.
