A water and wastewater utility in Florida defended itself against a legal action brought by the Environmental Protection Agency relating to alleged violations of the Clean Water Act. Although the utility faced over \$100 million in potential civil penalties, the court found the utility guilty of only minor violations and assessed a final penalty of approximately \$300,000. The utility incurred over \$3.5 million in legal expenses defending itself and has petitioned the Florida Public Service Commission to recover the litigation costs through a surcharge to its customers over a ten year period.
