PROCEDURES AFTER CUSTOMER MEETINGS

After the meetings, PSC staff will prepare a recommendation which is scheduled to be submitted to the PSC on April 30, 1998. The PSC will then vote on staff's recommendation at its May 12, 1998 agenda conference. The PSC will thereafter issue a proposed agency action (PAA) order containing its findings. Under the PAA process, the case will not be set for a formal Commission hearing unless a timely protest to the PSC's proposed action is filed. up to speak. PSC staff will be available to coordinate customer comments and to assist members of the public.

All persons who wish to comment are urged to be present at the beginning of the meeting, since the meeting may be adjourned early if no customers are present. The meeting will begin as scheduled and will continue until all the customers have been heard.

In addition to the customer meeting to be held on March 4, 1998, the PSC staff will be available on the morning of March 5, 1998, to meet with individual customers who desire a more in-depth discussion of the issues. PSC staff has reserved Room No. 2 of the Eastmonte Civic Center from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on March 5, 1998, to meet with individual customers who wish to be present. Appointments may be set up either by contacting Mr. Bob Casey of the PSC staff at (850) 413-6974, prior to March 4, 1998, or by signing up during the customer meeting on March 4, 1998.

All persons who wish to participate in individual meetings are urged to make an appointment, since the individual meetings may be canceled if no customers sign up.

Notice is hereby given that Sanlando Utilities Corporation (Sanlando or utility) has applied to the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) for approval of a Reuse Project Plan and increase in rates for wastewater service provided to its customers in Seminole County, Florida. This application is being processed under PSC Docket No. 971186-SU.

THE APPLICATION

The applicant's St. Johns River Water Management District (SJWMD) Consumptive Use Permit Number 2-117-0006UR2, issued November 11, 1997, and proposed renewal of their Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Wastewater Permit Number FL0036251 require that the Utility implement a reuse program. To satisfy the permit conditions, the Utility proposes to construct a reuse treatment facility and transmission and distribution mains. The project is designed to provide reclaimed water to four customersthree golf courses and a commercial nursery. The applicant has requested that the Commission establish reuse rates and increase wastewater rates to recover the cost of the Reuse Project. Two rate structures are proposed. The first proposed rate structure places all costs with the wastewater customers. It addresses the initial situation where no reuse irrigation customers are available. The second proposed rate divides the costs among the wastewater customers and the reuse irrigation customers. TF addresses the situation where the facilities are constructed and all four reuse irrigation customers are connected. As reuse irrigation customers become available the Utility will commensurately reduce the additional rates being charged the wastewater customers until they fall to the lower proposed rate.

This application is being filed pursuant to Section 367.0817, Florida Statutes, which provides that all prudent costs of a reuse project shall be recovered in a utility's rates. The Florida Legislature has found that reuse benefits water, wastewater, and reuse customers. Section 367.0817, Florida Statutes, requires the PSC to allow a utility to recover the costs of a reuse project from the utility's water, wastewater, or reuse customers, or any combination thereof, as it deems appropriate. Therefore, while the utility has proposed that the entire cost of the reuse project be recovered from its wastewater rates, <u>the PSC may find it</u> <u>appropriate for the costs to be shared in a different manner</u>.
