## BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S MOTION TO HOLD SUBSIDY PAYMENTS IN ESCROW OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, MAKE SUBSIDY PAYMENTS SUBJECT TO REFUND

NOW COMES BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.037, Florida Administrative Code, and moves the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") to allow BellSouth to hold the subsidy payments BellSouth makes to GTC, Inc. ("GTC"), in escrow until the Commission reaches a decision on this matter or, in the alternative, require GTC to hold the subsidy payments subject to refund. In support thereof, BellSouth states the following:

1. On July 22, 1997, BellSouth filed its Revised Petition to Remove the InterLATA Access Subsidy received by GTC (St. Joseph).

2. The hearing on this matter is currently scheduled for May 20, 1998. GTC, however, is disputing certain orders of the Prehearing Officer regarding discovery in this matter. It is possible that the hearing in this matter will be delayed.

3. BellSouth continues to pay GTC approximately \$120,000 per month in access subsidies.

4. BellSouth moves the Commission to allow BellSouth to pay these monies into an interest bearing escrow account until the Commission reaches a DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

decision in this matter. BellSouth believes that this action is appropriate because it eliminates the incentive for GTC to delay this proceeding. Moreover, GTC continues to argue that the Commission does not have authority over the access subsidy payments. Placing the payments in escrow pending a final decision protects both parties.

5. In the alternative, BellSouth moves the Commission to require GTC to hold the subsidy payments subject to refund and post a bond to guarantee the potential refund amount. This action would protect BellSouth from potential loss of the refund if GTC is sold, or if GTC does not have the financial capability of paying the refund in the future. Order No. 14452, issued on June 10, 1985, indicates that "all subsidies pool contributions and receipts are subject to refund."

WHEREFORE, BellSouth requests that the Commission require BellSouth to pay the access subsidy payments in an interest bearing escrow account until the Commission reaches a decision in this matter or, in the alternative, require GTC to hold the subsidy payments subject to refund with a posted bond.
