ALLTEL FLORIDA, INC.'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

ALLTEL Florida, Inc. ("ALLTEL" or the "Company"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files this Request for Confidential Classification for certain information provided to the Staff in this docket, and says:

- 1. This request covers pages 3 and 6 of ALLTEL's traffic study filed on April 14, 1998, in this docket. The traffic study was filed pursuant to Order No. PSC-98-0098-FOF-TL.
- 2. In accordance with FPSC Rule No. 25-22.006, F.A.C., a copy of the document with the information ALLTEL considers to be proprietary has been filed under a separate cover as Exhibit "A" to this request and has the confidential information highlighted for identification purposes. In accordance with Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, ALLTEL has appended hereto as Exhibit "B" one edited copy of the traffic study with this confidential information blacked out ("redacted").
- 3. Commission Rule 25-22.006(4)(a) provides that a utility may satisfy its burden of proving that information is specified confidential material by demonstrating how the information falls

under one or more of the available statutory examples. In the alternative, if no statutory example is available, the utility may satisfy its burden by including a justifying statement indicating what penalties or ill effects on ALLTEL or its ratepayers will result from the disclosure of the information to the public. ALLTEL has identified this confidential information on a line-by-line basis, and has appended such line-by-line identification hereto as Exhibit "C."

- 4. The information for which confidential treatment is requested has not been disclosed, except pursuant to a protective agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public.
- 5. For all the foregoing reasons, ALLTEL respectfully urges the Commission to classify the above-described and discussed document as proprietary confidential business information pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and as such exempt from Chapter 119, Florida Statutes.

WHEREFORE, ALLTEL Florida, Inc. moves the Commission to enter an Order declaring this information to be proprietary confidential business information pursuant to Section 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

Edited (Redacted) Version of Document With Confidential Information Blacked Out

All traffic data collected for the calling rate computation for this study is based on the October 1997 billing period. Calling main stations for this study includes 1B, Semi-Public Paystations, PBX Trunks, Key System Lines, Centrex, Customer-Owned Paystations, and 1R. Calling main totals differ from access line totals. Access line totals include Public Paystations and Special Services (Private Lines, Special Access, FX, and Wats.) Totals on both counts exclude test lines and official company lines.

All community of interest factors reported in this study are based on only the usage which ALLTEL bills on behalf of specific interexchange carriers. To the extent other IXC's may be carrying traffic of which we are unaware, the community of interest may be affected. Usage of this type is not available for study by ALLTEL since we do not perform the recording and billing function for all carriers.

FX Lines 1. Fort White (Closed End) - Gainesville - 0

The communities of interest for the citizens residing in the Fort White area for calling to Gainesville are the University of Florida, Medical Facilities, employment, shopping, entertainment, and calling of friends and family.

On the enclosed map the existing EAS routes are shown with solid arrows and the proposed routes are shown with broken arrows.

DEMOGRAPHIC DESCRIPTIONS

Fort White

The Fort White Wire Center is located in the southwestern portion of Columbia County. This exchange covers approximately 65 square miles including the unincorporated areas of Wilson Springs and Hollingworth Bluff. The subscriber density for the Fort White service area for October 1997 is projected to have a total of 24.7 customer access lines per square mile.

This central office is a Northern Telecom DMS 10 which provides custom calling and class features for this area.

Note 1: This traffic data is numbers of main stations, messages, M/A/M and percentage of customers making two or more calls, and call distribution data for the Ft. White - Gainesville route. This data for the routes at issue in this proceeding basically provide a blueprint of the toll usage over these routes. Competition in the intraLATA toll market is increasing, and the FPSC has authorized intraLATA presubscription should be implemented. This means that ALLTEL may be subject to presubscribed competition on this route.

Although the traffic information is clearly necessary for a full examination of the merits of the extended area service

request in this case, such information also contains data that indicates which routes at issue in this case contain the most concentrated traffic. The disclosure of such traffic patterns to the public would make available to competitors highly valuable competitive information which such competitors could use to target the most lucrative routes. This disclosure would harm the company by making sensitive traffic data available to competitors at no cost.

Note 2: This page shows number of access lines for the Ft. White exchange. As the telecommunications market becomes more competitive, disclosure of this type of information will give competitors important information on market size and growth. More specifically, access line statistics are an indication of how profitable the market can be once entered. These statistics provide potential competitors with accurate demographic information at no cost, which information can be used to compete against and harm ALLTEL.
