Please accept this as our response to your March 5th letter regarding the aforementioned utility. You are accurate in stating that the customers of Imperial Bonita Associates, d/b/a Imperial Bonita Estates were inter-connected with Bonita Springs Utilities, Inc. on September 3, 1993. After inter-connection, the customers were billed directly from Bonita Springs Utilities for their sewage service. Immediately after this inter-connection, the abandonment procedures were followed to abandon the sewer plant and its subsequent removal. This was all completed prior to the May 16, 1994 date, at which time, Imperial Bonita Associates and Imperial Bonita Properties conveyed the ownership interest (via Warranty Deed) to Imperial Bonita Homeowners Association, Inc. At the conclusion of that tax year, Imperial Bonita Associates and Imperial Bonita Properties Corporation were both dissolved and our management contract was terminated.

Between the time of inter-connection and the sale of this parcel, there were no billings to the residents for either sewage treatment or any part of the wastewater collection system. In regard to the 1993 annual operating report, a representative of our office, Dick Leiter, had spoken with Valerie Moore on 3/31/94 at the Florida Department of Water Utilities, 904-488-8482, regarding this report. Her response was that, "Imperial Bonita Associates was listed as inactive and therefore, no return was due. Also, no annual report is due either as Bonita Springs Utilities, Inc., would have that responsibility." To our knowledge, all other reports had been filed and all other fees had been paid prior to its sale.
