## AMENDATORY\_ORDER

On January 23, 1998, Supra Telecommunications and Information filed a Complaint against Systems Supra) BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) for alleged violations of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act) and Petition for resolution of Supra certain disputes between BellSouth and regarding interpretation of the Interconnection, Resale, and Collocation Agreements between Supra and BellSouth (Petition). Supra also requested relief on an emergency basis. On February 16, 1998, BellSouth filed its Answer and Response to Supra's Petition. This matter has been set for hearing on an expedited basis.

By Order No. PSC-98-0583-PCO-TP, issued April 27, 1998, among other things, I allowed BellSouth additional time to file testimony rebutting witness Hamilton's Amended Direct Testimony. Due to a scrivener's error, that Order indicated that BellSouth had until April 24, 1998, to file that testimony. The date that should have been reflected in the Order was, however, April 28, 1998. Therefore, I hereby amend Order No. PSC-98-0583-PCO-TP to reflect that BellSouth had until April 28, 1998, to file testimony rebutting the amended direct testimony of witness Hamilton.

Based on the foregoing, it is therefore

ORDERED by Commissioner E. Leon Jacobs, Jr., as Prehearing Officer, that Order No. PSC-98-0583-PCO-TP is amended as set forth in the body of this Order. It is further
