This is in response to your letters dated April 27 and 29, 1997 regarding the referenced dockets. Mr. Jaeger is currently out of the office until May 18, 1998. Therefore, pending Mr. Jaeger's return, please direct correspondence to me regarding your progress in making customer refunds.
Regarding your objection to the Office of Public Counsel's (OPC) intervention in Docket No. 921098-WS, Section 350.0611(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes OPC to appear on behalf of the citizens of Florida in any proceeding or action before the Commission. Therefore, OPC's intervention is a matter of statutory right, and we cannot consider your objection to OPC's intervention. By Order No. PSC-98-0560-PCO-WS, the Commission acknowledged OPC's intervention in this matter.
Finally, I have reviewed your response to show cause Order No. PSC-98-0444-SC-WS, which includes your proposal for payment of Turkey Creek's delinquent, 1993 regulatory assessment fees, penalty and interest. In the past, the Commission has authorized payment plans for regulatory assessment fees, penalty and interest. However, I am unaware of any case where the Commission has considered and approved a proposal for a delayed payment as you suggest. Typically, the Commission requires monthly payments which commence immediately following Commission approval of the payment plan. Therefore, you may wish to reconsider your proposal.
