#### SECTION 2 - RULES, REGULATIONS AND SERVICE QUALITY CRITERIA

#### 2.1 Undertaking of Worldlink Long Distance, Corp -

The Company's services and facilities are furnished for communications originating at specified points within the State of Florida under terms of this tariff

The Company's services and facilities are furnished for communications provided in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth under this tariff. It may act as the customer's agent for ordering access connection facilities provided by other carriers or entities when authorized by the customer, to allow connection of a customer's location to the company's network. The customer shall be responsible for all charges due for such service arrangement.

The Company's services and facilities are provided on a monthly basis unless ordered on a longer term basis, and are available twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week.

#### 2.2 Limitations

- 2.2.1 Service is offered subject to the availability of facilities and provisions of this tariff.
- 2.2.2 The Company reserves the right to discontinue furnishing service, or limit the use of service necessitated by conditions beyond its control, or when the customer is using service in violation of the law or the provisions of this tariff.
- 2.2.3 All facilities provided under this tariff are directly controlled by the Company and the customer may not transfer or assign the use of service or facilities, except with the express written consent of the Company, such transfer or assignment shall only apply where there is no interruption of the use or location of the service or facilities.

2.2.1 Refusal or Discontinuance of Service by Company.

As applicable, the company may refuse or discontinue telephone service under the following conditions provided that, unless otherwise stated, the customer shall be given notice and allowed a reasonable time to comply with any rule or remedy and deficiency:

- 2.2.4.A. For noncompliance with or violation of any state or municipal law, ordinance, or regulation pertaining to telephone service.
- 2.2.4.B. For the use of telephone service for any other property or purpose than that described in the application.
- 2.2.4.C. For failure of refusal to provide the company with a deposit to insure payment of bills in accordance with the company's regulation.
- 2.2.4.D. For neglect or refusal to provide reasonable access to the company for the purpose of inspection and maintenance of equipment owned by the Company.
- 2.2.4.E. For noncompliance with or violation of the Commission's regulations or the Company's rules and regulations on file with the Commission, provided 5 working days' written notice is given before termination.
- 2.2.4.F. For nonpayment of bills for telephone service, including the telecommunications access system surcharge provided that suspension or termination of service shall not be made without 5 working day written notice to the customer, except in extreme cases. The written notice shall be separated and apart from the regular monthly bill for service. The Company shall not, however, refuse or discontinue service to any customer for the initial nonpayment of the current bill on a day the company's business office is closed or on a day preceding a day the business office is closed.

- 2.2.4.G Without notice in the event of customer use of equipment in such manner as to adversely effect the Company's equipment or the Company's service to others.
- 2.2.4.H Without notice in the event of hazardous conditions or tampering with the equipment furnished and owned by the Company.
- 2.2.4.1 Without notice in the event of unauthorized or fraudulent use of service whenever service is discontinued for fraudulent use of service. The Company may, before restoring service, require the customer to make, at his own expense, all changes in facilities or equipment necessary to eliminate illegal use and to pay an amount reasonably estimated as the loss in revenues resulting from such fraudulent use.
- 2.2.4.J In case of refusal to establish service, or whenever service is discontinued, the Company shall notify the applicant or customer in writing of the reason for such refusal or discontinuance.
- 2.3 Liabilities of Worldlink Long Distance, Corp. -
  - 2.3.1 The Company's liability for damages arising out of mistakes, interruptions, omissions, delays, errors, or defects in the transmission occurring in the course of furnishing service or facilities, and not caused by the negligence of its employees or its agent, in no event shall exceed and amount equivalent to the proportionate charge to the customer for the period during which the aforementioned faults in transmission occur.
  - 2.3.2 The company shall be indemnified and held harmless by the customer against:
    - A) Claims for libel, slander, or infringement of copyright arising out of the material, data, information, or other content transmitted over the company's facilities.
    - B) All other claims arising out of any act or omission of the customer in connection with any service of facility provided by the Company.

- 2.4.1 Credit allowance for the interruption of service which is not due to the Company's testing, adjusting, negligence of the customer, or to the failure of equipment provided by the customer, are subject to the general liability provisions set forth in 2.3.1 herein. It shall be the obligation of the customer to notify the Company immediately of any interruption in service for which a credit allowance is desired. Before giving such notice, the customer shall ascertain that the trouble is not being caused by any equipment furnished by the customer and connected to the Company's facilities. No refund or credit will be made for the timer that the Company stands ready to repair the service and the subscriber does not provide access to the Company for such restoration work.
- 2.4.2 No credit shall be allowed for an interruption of a continuous duration of less than twenty-four hours after the subscriber notifies the Company.
- 2.4.3 The customer shall be credited for an interruption of more than twenty-four hours as follows:

Credit Formula:

Credit - A/B x C

"A" - outage time in hours

"B" - 720 hours

"C"- total monthly charge for affected facility

2.5 Deposits

The Company does not require a deposit from the customer.

2.6 Advance Payments

For customers whom the Company feels an advance payment is necessary, the Company reserves the right to collect an amount not to exceed one (1) month's estimated charges as an advance payment for service. This will be applied against the next month's charges and if necessary a new advance payment will be collected for the next month.
