Dear Mrs. Bayo:

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, BellSouth and Express Phone Company are submitting to the Florida Public Service Commission their amendment to their negotiated agreement for the purchase of BellSouth's telecommunications services for the purpose of resale to end users by Express Phone Company An initial resale agreement between these two parties is already on file with the Commission. This is the second amendment to this agreement; however, the first amendment pertained only to Tennessee.

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Act, the Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the amendment to the negotiated agreement between BellSouth and Express Phone Company within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the agreement or any portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or the implementation of the agreement or any portion of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Both parties aver that neither of these reasons exist as to the agreement they have negotiated and therefore, are very hopeful that the Commission shall approve their amendment.

AMENDMENT TO THE RESALE AGREEMENT BETWEEN LOCAL PHONE SERVICE COMPANY AND BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. DATED APRIL 20, 1998

Pursuant to this Agreement, (the "Amendment") Local Phone Service Company ("Reseller") and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties," hereby agree to amend that certain Resale Agreement between the Parties dated April 20, 1998 ("Resale Agreement").

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual provisions contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- Local Phone Service Company has changed the name of said business to Express Phone Company, an Alabama sole proprietorship. The Resale Agreement is hereby amended to reflect the name change.
- All of the other provisions of the Resale Agreement, dated April 20, 1998 shall remain in full force and effect.
- Either or both of the Parties is authorized to submit this Amendment to each Public Service Commission for approval subject to Section 252(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
