E. STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS:

ISSUE 1:

Should the Commission approve the industry's consensus overlay plan for the 407 area code relief, and if not, what relief plan should the Commission approve?

AT&T:

While there are advantages and disadvantages of either imposing an overlay as proposed by Lockheed Martin IMS or a geographic split, AT&T suggests that the advantages associated with the split outweigh those associated with an overlay. From a technical standpoint, AT&T will support either one. The determining factor should be what is in the best interests of the people living and working within the 407 area code.

ISSUE 2: What should the dialing pattern be for the following types of calls?

- a. Local
- b. Toll
- c. EAS
- d. ECS

AT&T:

If the Commission approves an overlay, 10-digit dialing should be required within and between the new and old area codes for all types of calls. In addition, toll calls should be made on a 1+10 digit basis. If the Commission approves a geographic split, 10-digit dialing should be required between the new and old area dialing codes for all types of calls. In addition, toll calls should be made on a 1+10-digit basis. Local, ECS and EAS calls within an area code may be on a seven digit basis.
