Please Note:

As of April 1, 1998 there was a change in the numbers of customers served by several of the gas suppliers. This is due to one supplier leaving the program and to customer dissatisfaction with their supplier. The changes were as follows:

- one customer changed gas suppliers from CNB Olympic Gas to PG&E.
- one customer switched to Enron Energy when El Paso Energy left the pilot.
- another customer, who had 26 facilities participating in the pilot, switched from e'prime and Texas-Ohio Pipeline to Enron Energy.
