BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Request For Confidential Classification, and states the following:

- In Memorandum dated September 4, 1998, the Floirida Public Service Commission ("Commission"), issued four data requests to BellSouth on access by telecommunications companies to Multi-Tenant Environments.
 BellSouth is now filing a Request for Confidential Classification for the subject information.
- BellSouth has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as Attachment A a listing of the location of the information designated by BellSouth as proprietary.
- Appended hereto as Attachment B are two copies of the subject exhibit with the proprietary information deleted.
- Appended hereto as Attachment C is a sealed envelope containing one copy of the exhibit, including the material which is proprietary.

- 5. The subject exhibit contains information related to vendor compensation amounts that BellSouth has negotiated with specific vendors. Specifically, the subject information entails the initial and sales activity-specific compensation amounts that BellSouth offers its vendors on particular items. If this information were publicly disclosed, it would impair BellSouth's ability to obtain favorable compensation arrangements in the future. Accordingly, this information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to F.S. § 364.183.
- BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.
- The original of this Notice has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, BellSouth moves the Commission to enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.
