BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Request For Confidential Classification, and states the following:

- 1. On August 4, 1998, Supra Telecommunications and Information Systems, Inc. ("Supra") served its First Request for Production of Documents, Nos. 1 through 22 on BellSouth. On September 3, 1998, BellSouth filed its Responses and Objections to Supra's First Request for Production, and produced certain confidential documents pursuant to a Protective Agreement. On October 13, 1998, Staff requested a copy of these documents. In order to allow Staff to have copies of certain documents, specifically those produced in response to Requests 6, 8, 9, and 17, BellSouth is now filing a Request for Confidential Classification for these documents, which contain information considered to be confidential and proprietary to BellSouth.
- On September 15, 1998, Supra served its Second Request for
 Production of Documents, Nos. 23 through 56, on BellSouth. On September 23,
 1998, BellSouth filed its Objections to Supra's Second Request for Production,

DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE 12558 NOV-6器 and on October 14, 1998, BellSouth filed its Responses and Objections to Supra's Second Request for Production, and produced certain confidential documents pursuant to a Protective Agreement. On October 13, 1998, Staff requested a copy of these documents. In order to allow Staff to have copies of certain documents, specifically those produced in response to Requests 24, 27, 28, 32, 33, 34, 44, and 45, BellSouth is now filing a Request for Confidential Classification for these documents, which contain information considered to be confidential and proprietary to BellSouth.

- 3. On October 16, 1998, BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification for Staff's requests for copies of BellSouth's responses to the requests referred to in Paragraphs 1 and 2 above. The subject information of this discovery contains information considered to be confidential and proprietary to BellSouth in the above-captioned docket.
- 4. BellSouth is filing a Request for Confidential Classification for the subject information contained in the documents responsive to Requests 6, 8, 9, and 17 of Supra's First Request for Production of Documents, and Requests 24, 27, 28, 32, 33, 34, 44, and 45 of Supra's Second Request for Production of Documents, which is proprietary to BellSouth and includes information containing, among other things, vendor-specific and competitive business information. This information is clearly confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Section 364.183 and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

- 5. BellSouth has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as Attachment A a listing of the location of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.
- 6. Appended hereto as Attachment B are two copies of the requested documents with the confidential information deleted.
- Appended hereto as Attachment C is a sealed envelope containing one copy of the documents including the material which is confidential and proprietary.
- 8. The requested documents contain information considered to be confidential and proprietary to BellSouth, and includes information containing, among other things, vendor-specific information and competitive business information. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A. Public disclosure of this information would provide BellSouth's competitors with an unfair advantage. This same information on competitors is not available to BellSouth. This information is valuable, it is used by BellSouth in conducting its business and BellSouth strives to keep it secret. Therefore, such information should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

- 9. BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.
- 10. The original of this Notice has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, BellSouth moves the Commission to enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.

Explanation of Proprietary Information

- 1. The information requested concerns competitive business information. This information if released would be unfair to BellSouth for it would allow the competition to have free access to intellectual property which was developed at significant expense to BellSouth. Competitors would then have an advantage in bidding for such business since they would have few, if any, expenses such as market research and market development to recover, and would bid below BellSouth's cost level. Accordingly, this information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 364.183.
- 2. The subject information includes BellSouth's business plans, forecasts and other confidential business information of BellSouth. If this information were disclosed publicly, it would damage the competitive interests of BellSouth. Accordingly, this information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 364.183(3)(e).
- 3. This information contains the floor plans of BellSouth central offices. These plans are considered to be proprietary and confidential business information. These offices have limited access and are the central focal point of telecommunications in their geographic location. Public disclosure of this information would impair BellSouth's ability to keep these office and the communications network secure. This information is valuable, it is used by BellSouth in conducting its business and BellSouth strives to keep it secret. Therefore, such information is a trade secret which should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 363.183, Florida Statutes and is exempt from the open Records Act.

Explanation of Proprietary Information

- 4. This information reflects BellSouth's market strategy relating to it's competitive marketing position. Specifically this information discusses, describes and evaluates BellSouth's potential strategic responses to various competitive scenarios; sets forth and evaluates underlying components of specific competitive proposals along with supporting rationale such as results of market research and analysis; names of individuals assigned to certain projects; key details relating to the substance of such projects as well as developmental time frame information and implementation information; and discusses/evaluates recommendations on these potential competitive response. BellSouth's competitors can use this information to develop their own market strategy with which to thwart BellSouth's effort in this market. Thus, the disclosure of this information to BellSouth's competitors would impair BellSouth's ability to compete and is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(a) and (3)(e), Florida Statutes. In addition, this information is valuable as it is used by BellSouth in conducting its business and BellSouth strives to keep it secret. Therefore, this information is a trade secret which should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information exempt from the Open Records Act.
- 5. This information is considered by BellSouth to be employee personnel information unrelated to compensation, duties, qualifications or responsibilities. This information is a name and/or control number used to identify an employee in lieu of a social security number. Such information is expressly included in Section 364.183(3)(f), Florida Statutes, as proprietary confidential business information.
- 6. This information contains vendor specific information, and/or, vendor specific prices negotiated by BellSouth. Public disclosure of this information would impair BellSouth's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. This information is valuable, it is used by BellSouth in conducting its business and BellSouth strives to keep it secret. Therefore, such information is a trade secret which should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3) and (3)(d), Florida Statutes.
