

PURPOSE

The purpose of this prehearing conference is: (1) to define and further limit, if possible, the number of issues; (2) to determine the parties' positions on the issues; (3) to determine what facts, if any, may be stipulated; (4) to dispose of any motions or other matters that may be pending; and (5) to consider any other matters that may aid in the disposition of this case. By Order No. PSC-98-0509-PCO-SU, issued April 14, 1998, the Commission decided to reopen the record to take evidence on what flows should

be used in the numerator of the used and useful equation when the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) permits the wastewater treatment plant based on annual average daily flows. The Commission also recognized that the utility had been successful on appeal and had already been awarded its attorneys' fees. Therefore, any future costs associated with reopening the record, as well as the requested non-legal costs of \$14,036 incurred on appeal and not included in rates, shall also be considered at the upcoming hearing.
