Dear Ms. Bayó:

Florida Power concurs with the findings in the subject audit report. The Company would like to clarify, however, that the advertising costs in question relate solely to the most recent October 1997 - March 1998 audit period addressed by the report and not to any prior audit period, contrary to the comment under the heading *Expenses* on page 2 of the report that "noted advertising costs were not adjusted as recommended in a prior audit disclosure."

In addition, Florida Power has reviewed the *Elder Update* newspaper referenced on page 3 of the audit report and has determined that no allocation should be made to the ECCR for the costs associated with this publication. Accordingly, the \$5,000 allocation to the ECCR will be reversed.

In summary, Florida Power will make the necessary adjustments to remove \$57,292 (\$52,292 + \$5,000), plus interest, from recoverable ECCR expenses on its November books and records.
