- 1) The parties shall identify two categories of issues: those that are common to each petition and those that are unique to each petition.
- 2) All parties shall participate fully in the litigation of the issues that are common to both petitions. The Commission's decision on the common issues shall be binding on all parties.
- Only the parties directly involved will participate in the litigation of the issues that are unique to only one of the petitions. The non-affected petitioner shall not present testimony, conduct cross-examination, or file a brief with respect to the issues that affect only the other petitioner. The Commission's decision on the unique issues shall be binding only on the parties who litigated the issue.
