CASE BACKGROUND

The Commission repealed Rule 25-17.0833, Florida Administrative Code, effective June 9, 1997. This rule provided for annual planning hearings resulting in a Statewide Avoided Unit for pricing cogeneration. However, the Commission found that this rule was unnecessary since the annual Ten-Year Site Plan workshops have taken the place of docketed annual planning hearings.

DISCUSSION OF ISSUE

ISSUE 1: Should Docket No. 990004-EU be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes.

STAFF ANALYSIS: Prior to its repeal on June 9, 1997, Rule 25-17.0833, Florida Administrative Code, read as follows:

- (1) Upon petition or on its own motion, the Commission shall periodically review optimal generation and transmission plans from a statewide and individual utility perspective. In connection with these proceedings, the Commission shall consider the need for capacity from both a statewide and individual utility perspective, the adequacy of the transmission grid, and other strategic planning concerns affecting the Florida electric grid.
- (2) Upon petition, or on its own motion, the Commission, as needed, shall review individual utility generation and expansion plans at any time.

Docket No. 990004-EU was reserved by the Commission as a forum, if needed, to decide matters pertaining to annual planning hearings. With the repeal of Rule 25-17.0833, Florida Administrative Code, the annual Ten-Year Site Plan workshop fulfills the Commission's need to review utility planning activities. The Commission can open a docket at any time to address issues arising from the Ten-Year Site Plan workshops. In fact, the Commission has recently opened Docket No. 981890-EU to investigate the aggregate planned reserve margins for Peninsular Florida's electric utilities. Therefore, staff recommends that Docket No. 990004-EU be closed.
