 - a. Number of cold weather extreme days since 1979 similar to Christmas 1989
 - b. Megawatt firm load not served with an FRCC 15% reserve margin
- 3. Non-Firm Load
 - a. Currently planned as a percent of the reserve margin
 - Capping non-firm load (for example, 25% of the reserve margin)
 - c. Frequency and duration of interruptions
- 4. Reserve Margin Standard
 - a. FRCC 15%
 - b. A higher standard until peninsular experience obtained (for example, 25%)
 - c. Allocation of peninsular reserves among utilities
 - d. FRCC enforcement
 - e. Treatment of merchant plant capacity
 - f. Non-firm notice provisions to return to firm
- 5. Price Spikes
 - a. Price spike level at which firm or non-firm load is interrupted to avoid purchase
 - b. Price spike level at which firm or non-firm load is interrupted to <u>make sale</u>
