## STAFF'S POSTHEARING COMMENTS

Staff submits the following language to be added to Rule 25-30.425:

1. (6) The amount authorized for pass through rate adjustments shall not exceed the actual cost incurred and shall not exceed the incremental increase or decrease for the 12-month period.

Staff's concern has been that a utility should not be permitted to pass through a cost increase such that the resulting rate for any item subject to pass through rate increase treatment exceeds the actual cost incurred. Such a result could occur in some instances if a utility failed to pass through a decrease in a prior period. The addition of the above language will make clear - that such a result is not permissible. It is not intended that any pass through increase would be offset by a prior period's decrease — in cost when such action would reduce the rate to an amount below LEG \_\_\_\_\_ actual cost.

LIN 5 2. In addition, the terms "on equity" should be added to 25-OPC \_\_\_\_ 30.425(5)(e), so that it reads: RCH .

(f) The rate of return <u>on equity</u> that the utility is affirming it will not exceed pursuant to section 367.081(4; (c), F. S. . . ..
