Pursuant to notice issued December 21st, 1998, this time and place have been set aside for a prehearing in Docket Number 980002-EG, Energy Conservation Cost Recovery Clause.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. We'll take appearances. Can you hear me?

MS. COWDERY: This is Kathryn Cowdery with Ruden, McClosky, Smith, Schuster & Russell in Tallahassee, on behalf of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation.

MR. ROBINSON: This is James M. Robinson, of Macfarlane, Ferguson & McMullen, P.O. Box 1531, Tampa, Florida, 33601, appearing for Peoples Gas in the conservation cost recovery docket.

MR. BEASLEY: Jim Beasley with the law firm of Ausley & McMullen in Tallahassee. I'm representing Tampa Electric Company.

MR. PALECKI: Michael Palecki, 955 East 25th

Street, Hialeah, Florida, representing City Gas Company of Florida.

MR. HOFFMAN: Kenneth Hoffman, Post Office Box 551, Tallahassee, Florida, 32302, on behalf of Florida Public Utilities Company. MR. HOWE: I'm Roger Howe with the Office of the Public Counsel appearing on behalf of the citizens of the 5 State of Florida. MS. GORDON KAUFMAN: Vicki Gordon Kaufman, 7 McWhirter, Reeves, 117 South Gadsden Street, Tallahassee, 8 32301, appearing on behalf of the Florida Industrial Power 9 Users Group. 10 MS. JAYE: Grace A. Jaye on behalf Commission 11 staff. 12 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Grace, do we have any 13 preliminary matters to take up? 14 MS. JAYE: Yes, ma'am. It was brought to staff's 15 attention this morning that exhibits for Chesapeake 16 Utilities Corporation were inadvertently left out of the 17 draft prehearing order, and those will be inserted. PALECKI: Commissioner, this is Mike Palecki. 3 City Gas Company of Florida would stipulate to staff's 4 number, which is 239,738. 5 6 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Peoples Gas? 7 MR. ROBINSON: There is no stipulation at this 8 time. 9 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Is that also for --Is that the West Florida District? I'm sorry, if there is 10 11 no stipulation for Peoples Gas, then what is PGS-WFD? MR. ROBINSON: No, there is not. 12 13 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Any other changes? 14 Any other stipulations? 15 MR. HOFFMAN: Commissioner Clark, this is Ken 16 Hoffman for Florida Public Utilities. Our number agrees 17 with staff's number, so I think we have a stipulation on 18 Issue 1. 19 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. MR. BEASLEY: Commissioner, Jim Beasley for Tampa 20 Electric, the same would apply for Tampa Electric. 21 MR. HOWE: Commissioner Clark, this is Roger 22 23 Howe. For Public Counsel's position, we will agree with 24 staff. 25 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. I take it that leaves

only Peoples Gas has not stipulated? No, there is one other.

MR. ROBINSON: I apologize, Commissioner. There is -- just looking at this now, I see that there is a difference between our evidence as presented and the numbers of staff, and I have not been in contact or do I know of any contact to settle those discrepancies.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Is this Mr. Robinson?
MR. ROBINSON: Yes, it is.

MS. BULECZA-BANKS: This is Cheryl Bulecza-Banks speaking on behalf of staff. What has happened, apparently, in the PGS issues for their end-of-period true-up is they accidentally pulled the wrong amount off the form. They took a different number which is not the final end-of-period true-up. What they pulled was a variance, and they have to, essentially have to agree with staff because we have the same factors. In order to get the factors, they would have to have the same end-of-true-up amount. So I think they just need to get back with the staff at their company and verify that our numbers are actually accurate.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. And they'll have the opportunity to do that before we issue the order, right, the prehearing order?

MS. JAYE: Yes, Commissioner.

PALECKI: Commissioner, this is Mike Palecki. 7 City Gas Company would stipulate with staff's numbers, and 8 those are residential, 5.087 -- excuse me, 5.078 cents per 9 therm; commercial 1.189 cents per therm; and commercial 10 large volume, .972 cents per therm. 11 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Peoples Gas. 12 MR. ROBINSON: Commissioner, as to Peoples Gas, 13 we stipulate to the staff's numbers. 14 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. 15 MR. ROBINSON: As to the West Florida region for 16 Peoples Gas, we note that there is one rate class that has 17 been omitted from staff's recommendation; and that is, 18 19 commercial large volume transportation. That is our fourth line, and they do not include it, and we submitted it as 20 0.990. 21 22 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Is that acceptable to staff? MR. ROBINSON: Excuse me, Commissioner? 23 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Is that acceptable to staff? 24

MR. HOFFMAN: Commissioner Clark, we have reached a stipulation with the staff on Issue 2, which includes one contingency which I'll explain to you.

An issue was raised in the draft prehearing order concerning a three-thousand-dollar expense item which, not surprisingly, has a very minimal impact on our factor. And the issue concerns some expenditures for a conservation program that has been implemented for a number of years by the company called a "Good Cents Program." I had the opportunity to talk to staff shortly before the prehearing conference began, and we have reached a stipulation to allow the company to recover these expenditures while both staff and the company further explore the issue. provide some additional information to staff that they may need, and in the event staff would continue to take the position that the three-thousand expenditure should be disallowed and that position is taken at the next hearing, then the three thousand dollars would be refunded with an appropriate interest rate.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay.

MR. HOFFMAN: And I think I've accurately stated that.

MS. JAYE: Yes, sir, you have.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Then we'll show that 1 stipulated with that contingency. 2 COMMISSIONER CLARK: TECO. 3 MR. BEASLEY: Commissioner Clark, our numbers are 4 in agreement with those of the staff, so we can stipulate 5 6 these factors. 7 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Ms. Kaufman. MS. GORDON KAUFMAN: Commissioner Clark, FIPUG is 8 9 going to take no position on this issue. COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. 10 MR. HOWE: And, Commissioner Clark, this is Roger 11 12 Howe. Public Counsel will take no position on this issue. COMMISSIONER CLARK: Staff, it appears then that 13 14 we have a stipulation on Issue 2? MS. JAYE: Yes, ma'am. 15 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Issue 3, nobody has a 16 17 position but the staff on this? MS. JAYE: Commissioner, staff had, after some 18 deliberation, decided that we needed to clarify the 19 effective dates for the new conservation cost recovery 20 factors because of the contingencies involved in going from 21 the two times a year to one time a year for holding these 22 hearings, and staff had included this issue sort of as a 23 means to allow the companies to know exactly where we are 24

coming from and what is required. The companies have not
