The purpose of the meeting is to identify the appropriate issues to be decided in this remand proceeding so that the filing of testimony and prehearing statements will be simplified. For purposes of discussion, staff has listed the following draft issues:

ISSUE 7: In determining whether any portion of the interim increase granted should be refunded, how should the refund be calculated?

ISSUE 8: Based on the changes to the used and useful percentages, what are the appropriate allowance for funds prudently invested charges, and are any refunds of the charges collected subject to refund required?

**ISSUE 9:** What is the appropriate action that should be taken with regard to surcharges?

<u>ISSUE 10</u>: Should the utility be allowed to collect interest on the surcharges, and, if so, how should interest be calculated?

**ISSUE 11:** Should the utility be required to file tariff sheets and a proposed customer notice regarding surcharges?
