The Company seeks PSC approval pursuant to Chapter 25-8, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 366.04, Florida Statutes, for authority to: receive equity funds from the Southern Company ("Gulf's parent company"); issue and sell longterm debt and equity securities; and issue and sell short-term debt securities during the period covered by its petition.
