Issue 3: How should additional payment options through a third party vendor under this tariff be approved?

Recommendation: Issue 1 discusses two specific proposals. FPC should file any new third-party vendor options with the Commission 45 days prior to implementation. Staff should be granted the authority to approve administratively new proposals which are substantially similar to the two programs discussed in Issue No. 1.

Issue 4: Should this docket be closed?
Recommendation: Yes, if no protest is filed within 21 days of issuance of the order.
